- 3. SPIRITUAL SUPPORT PROGRAM FOR SECULAR FRANCISCANS WHO HAVE BEEN APPOINTED AS SA TO A FRATERNITY.
- 4. QUARTERLY EDITIONS TO SHARE THE VARIOUS CELEBRATIONS OF FRATERNITIES.
- 5. POLICY MANUAL...SUBJECT INDEX, UPDATE REVIEW, THE TRANSFER FORM AMENDED TO ALLOW A PROFESSED MEMBER TO TRANSFER WHEN ORIGINATING FRATERNITY NO LONGER EXIST

The above Plan will be implemented with Prayer and Diligence. More details will unfold and be shared with all Fraternities as we together continue to build Family, build Fraternity and GO AND REBUILD MY CHURCH.

Regional Council Members are also committed to continue their support of the current activities now within fraternities.
